



SOCIETY CODE OF ETHICS

1. All members shall ensure that, at all times, all dogs under their control, are properly housed, fed, watered, exercised and receive proper veterinary attention if and when required.
2. Members shall not allow dogs to roam or to cause a nuisance to neighbours or to those carrying out official duties.
3. Members must clean up after their dogs in public places or anywhere they are being trained or exhibited. In addition they shall ensure their dog wear properly I.D tagged collars and are kept fully leashed or under effective control at all times.
4. Members engaged in breeding must follow their respective breed clubs and Kennel club 'code of ethics'.
5. No member shall at any event or gathering organised by, or on behalf of the Society, carry out corrective or punitive treatment, or treat a dog in such a way that, in the reasonable opinion of the committee, could be described as 'harsh handling'.
6. Good sportsmanship, courtesy and consideration should be shown by members at all times, and disparaging remarks about fellow members, trainers or guests of the Society, or their dogs, are to be strongly discouraged.
7. This Code of Ethics should be read in conjunction with the Kennel Club Canine Code, TW&DCS's and Section Rules.
